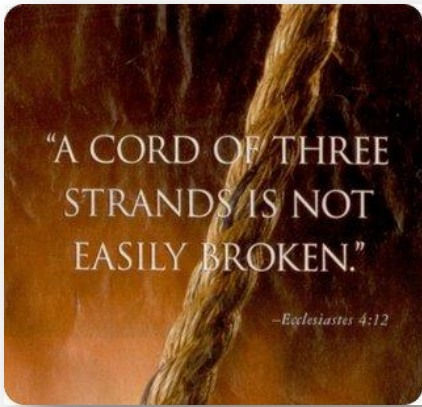

THE PROBLEM: •**Marriage:** The marriage rate has plunged 43% since 1970. •**Divorce:** Half of all new marriages still end in divorce. There have been 38 million divorces since 1970, hurting 35 million innocent victims – children. Children of divorce are three times as likely as those from intact homes to be expelled or to have a baby as a teenager, five times as apt to live in poverty and are 12 times more likely to be incarcerated. Even worse, when children of divorce become adults, only 60% marry, and they are more likely to divorce.

THE SETTING: Places of worship play a key role. They marry 86% of Americans, reports a Hart Poll. Barna estimates that 39% of Protestants have divorced – higher than the 38% divorce rate of atheists and agnostics. And 35% of born-again Americans have divorced. In fact 23% of those born-again have divorced twice! Among Pentecostals, the figure is 42% (but only 25% among Catholics).

REDEMPTIVE MARITAL THERAPY (RMT): The best of current research combined with biblical principles will equip counselors with practical helps which will speak to the hearts and minds of couples in the subculture of practicing Judeo-Christian faith. Clinicians, Coaches, and Pastors will come away with a framework for addressing distressed marriages.
